

MAINTENANCE OF WAY - TRACK LABORERS

Duties include, but not limited to:

- Track construction, installation of ties, switches, rails and other track materials
- Use of power and non-power tools
- Clearing the right of way of litter
- Repair and maintenance of equipment
- · Welding, grinding and cutting
- Read and comprehend operating and maintenance instructions, gauges and dials on precision measuring tools
- Apply concepts of basic shop procedures, math including calculating figures and amounts such as area, circumference, length, distances and volume

REQUIREMENTS:

- 18 years or older
- High School Diploma or GED
- Commercial Motor Vehicle License CDL-A, minimum 1 year experience, "O" restriction acceptable
- Able to walk on uneven surface and stand for long periods of time
- Able to carry and lift 100 lbs. and push and pull 250 lbs.
- Bend, stoop and kneel for long periods of time
- The candidate will be regularly exposed to outside weather conditions and elements as well as noise, and fumes from gas, oils and grease
- The candidate will be available for overtime and weekend work as required, and on call for emergencies at any time

Must wear personal protective equipment such as safety glasses, safety vest, safety boots, hard hats, and hearing protection where the company requires. Employee will be working:

- Indoors in a shop environment, and frequently outdoors, regardless of weather conditions
- With, on, and around moving or rotating heavy equipment
- Sometimes in confined spaces
- Fast-paced environment
