



# Railcar Repair Department

## Position Summary:

A Railcar Repair Inspector's responsibilities include but are not limited to the inspection, repair and maintenance of the mechanical and safety appliances of a railcar. Must have a working knowledge of hand tools and to be able to work in adverse seasonal conditions.

## General duties include:

- Ability to interpret instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram form.
- Conduct inspections to identify defects, evidence of wear, and damages to equipment.
- Must be willing to learn and comprehend state and federal regulations as it relates to railroad industry.
- Must be willing to learn the interchange rules as they pertain to freight cars.
- Learn and perform air tests, inspect, and repair freight cars or components for structural defects and wear according to FRA guidelines.
- Comply with railroad safety and operating rules.

## Job requirements:

- 18 years of age or older.
- High School Diploma or GED.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Must be able to submit to and be able to pass a drug screen/background check.
- Must be able to work with a team, take direction from supervisors, adhere to work schedules, focus attention on details, and follow work rules.
- Must be able to work varying shifts, including weekends and overtime as required.
- Must be able to work in varying weather conditions.
- Must be willing to wear required personal protective equipment.

## Physical requirements:

- Must be able to stand and walk on uneven surfaces for extended periods of time.
- Must be able to carry and lift 30 lbs. frequently and push and pull 75 lbs. frequently.
- Must be able to carry and lift occasionally 50-90 lbs., push and pull 250 lbs. and grip 100 lbs.
- Must be able to lift heavy objects (Parts, Tools, etc.).
- Must be able to bend, stoop, twist, kneel, squat.
- Must be able to work at heights of 18' or more.

## Rate of pay:

- \$24.00 to \$26.00 depending on experience and relevant qualifications.
